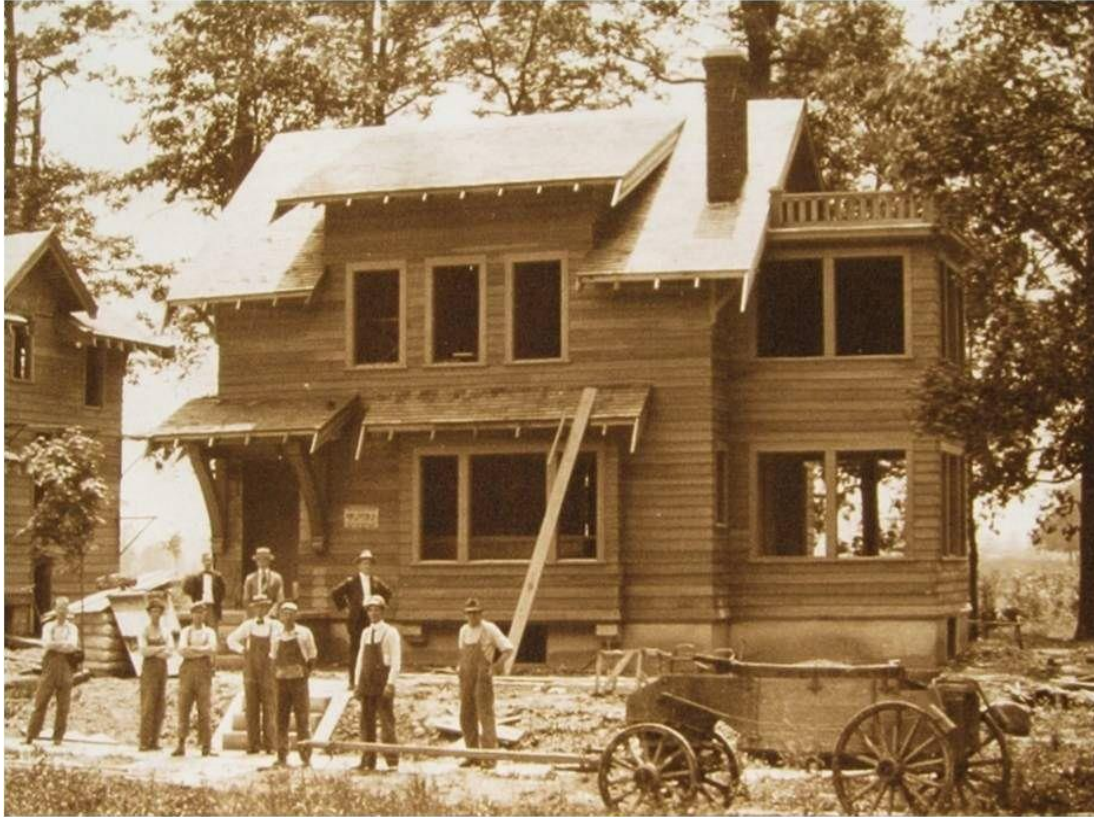


Come to the Wright Memorial Library and Enjoy . . .
